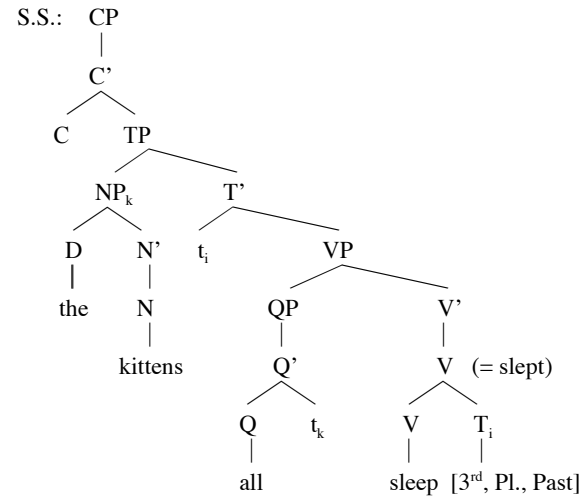
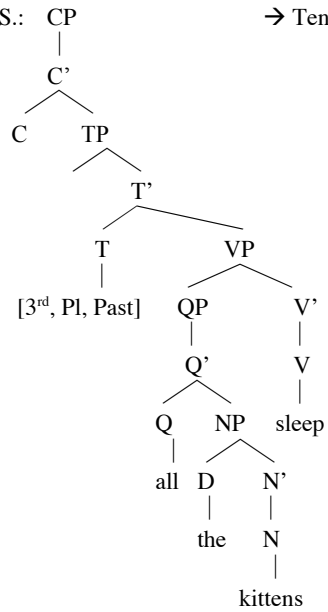


Ling 315, Assignment 8. Solution.

Part A. Provide derivations for the following examples.

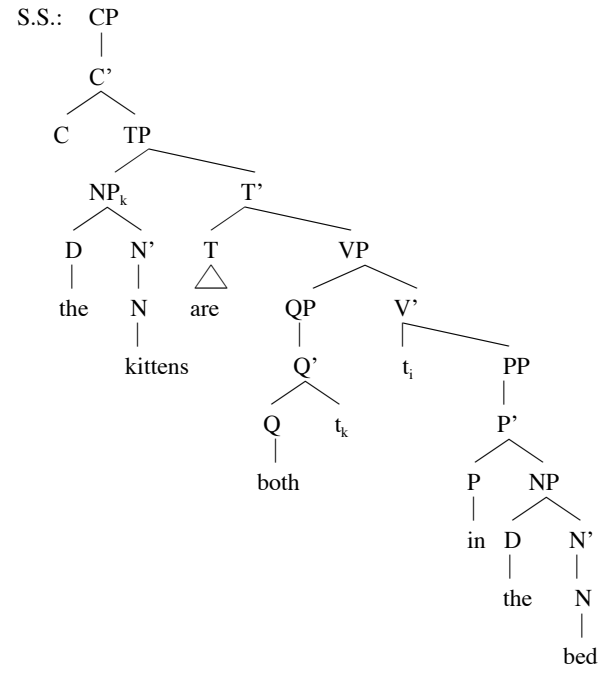
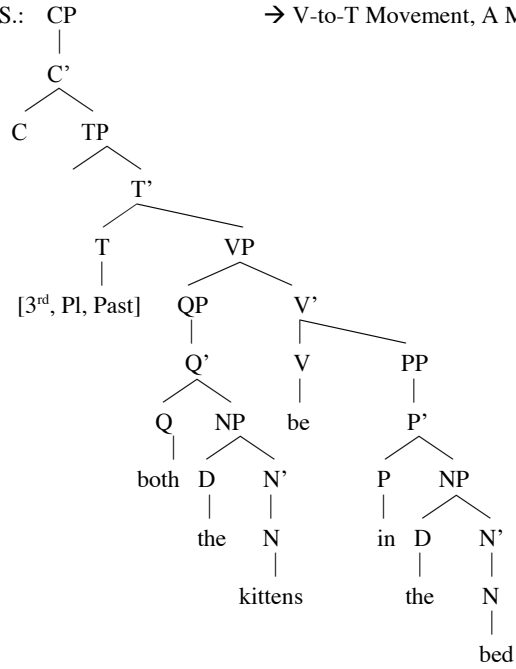
(1) The kittens all slept.

D.S.: CP → Tense Hopping, A Movement



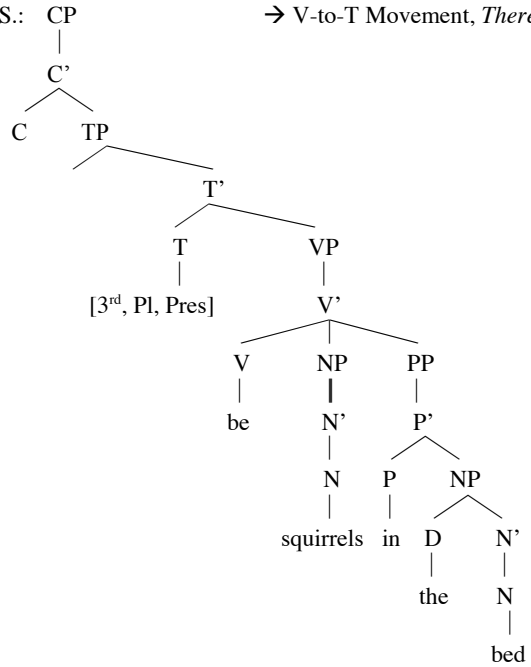
(2) The kittens are both in the bed.

D.S.: CP → V-to-T Movement, A Movement

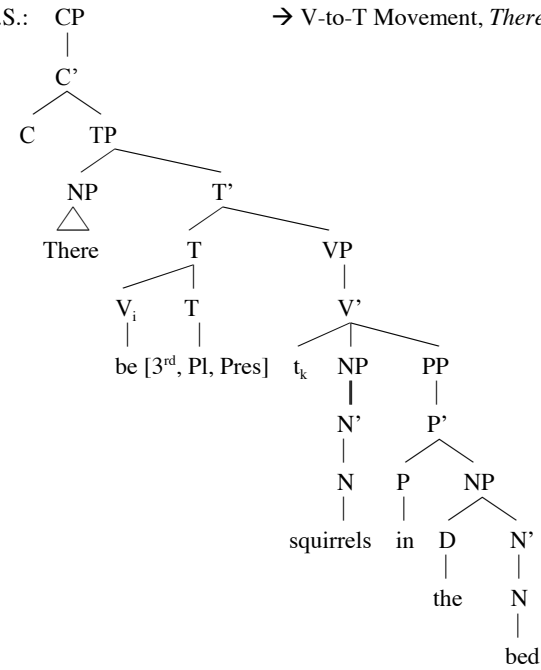


(3) There are squirrels in the bed.

D.S.: CP → V-to-T Movement, *There*-insertion



S.S.: CP → V-to-T Movement, *There*-insertion

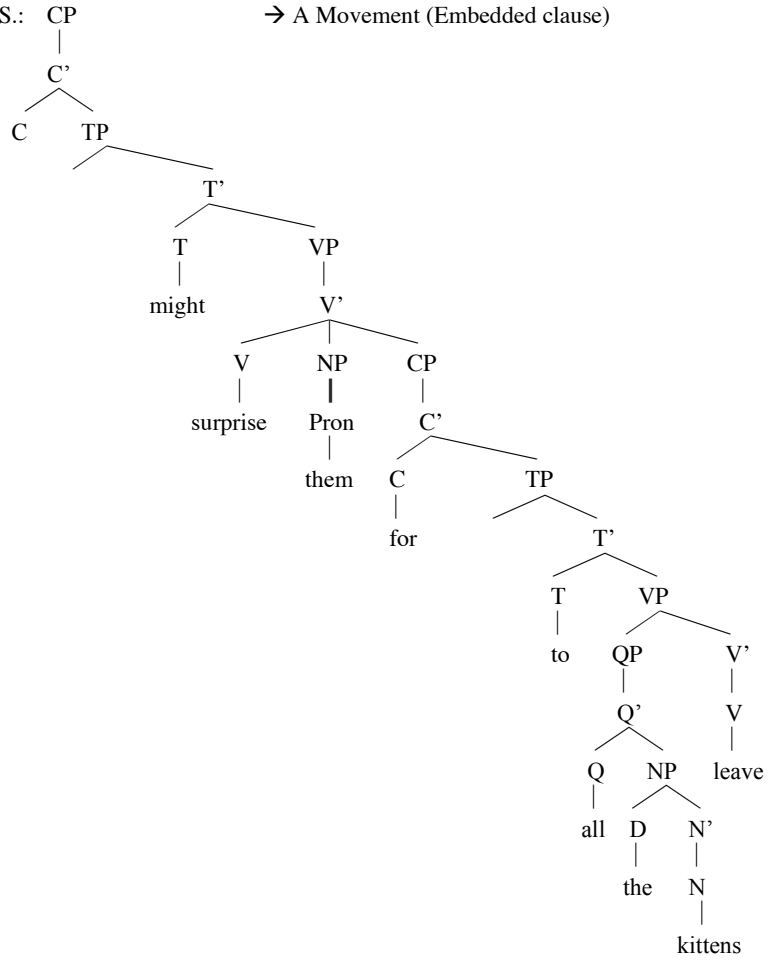


Part B. Our grammar does not yet account for the (b) examples of the following:
